We are pleased to provide internist and subspecialist attendees with the opportunity to earn credit toward renewing their certificates through ABIM's MOC program. Participants will need to be present for the ABIM MOC learning sessions on November 5, 2017 at the Renaissance Denver Hotel.

These interactive sessions will present five modules: **2017-2018 Update in Geriatric Medicine, 2017-2018 Update in Internal Medicine, 2017-2018 Update in Hospital Medicine, 2017-2018 Update in Critical Care Medicine** and **Hospital QI & Patient Safety MKM IV**. Each module will be conducted in about 2 hours time. After these sessions, ABIM-certified physicians will be able to complete the ABIM MOC medical knowledge modules at home and earn 48 points (if all five modules are complete – 10 points per module except 8 points for the Hospital QI MKM IV module) toward the Self-Evaluation of Medical Knowledge requirement within the Maintenance of Certification program.

Maintenance of Certification promotes lifelong learning and the enhancement of the clinical judgment and skills essential for high quality patient care. Now every 2 years, internists and subspecialists certified in or after 1990 renew their certificates through ABIM's Maintenance of Certification program. Those certified prior to that date are strongly urged to participate since the program helps improve the quality of care delivered to patients.

Note: You must be enrolled in ABIM's Maintenance of Certification program to submit completed medical knowledge modules for scoring, feedback reports, and eligibility to receive Maintenance of Certification and CME credit.
