FORMAT

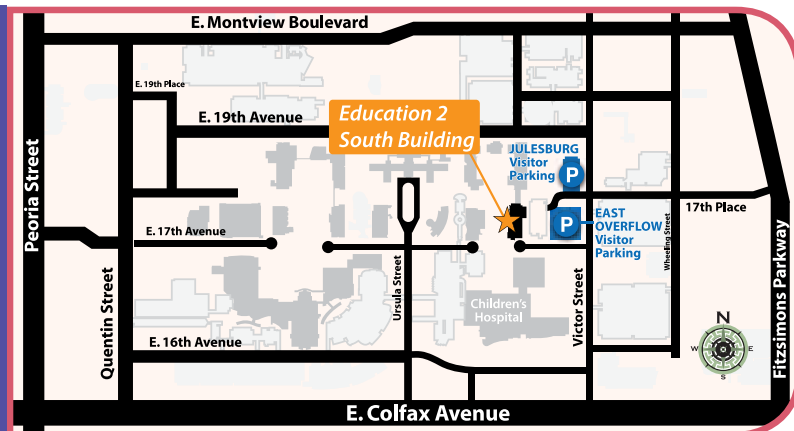
